The Lomita Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard on Monday, February 8, 2021, to consider the following:

AMENDMENT TO CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 299: A request to modify a mixed-use project consisting of 20 residential condominiums and 5 office condominiums to reduce the required percentage of nonresidential uses by converting Unit 3 and Unit 4 from an office condominium to residential condominiums allowing for live/work space, and to confirm the categorical exemption, located at 2154 250th Street, in the C-G, Commercial General Zone, Mixed-Use Overlay District. Filed by Cherine Medawar, 3453 Newridge Drive, Rancho Palos Verdes, CA 90275 (the "Applicant").
